**Places of Interest:**

① **Yokohama Museum of Art** (横浜美術館) Tel. (045)221-0300, specializes in modern and contemporary art. The building was designed by Kenzo Tange, a noted Japanese architect. Access: 3-min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta., Open: 10:00-18:00, until 20:00 on every Fri. when Special Exhibitions are held (enter 30 min. before closing time). Closed: Thu. (open when Thu. falls on a national holiday and is closed on the following day), and the New Year's holiday. Admission: ¥500 for Permanent Collections. For Special Exhibitions, fees differ in each exhibition.

② **Kanagawa Prefectural Museum of Cultural History** (神奈川県立歴史博物館) Tel. (045)201-0926, was constructed in 1904 in the German Neobaroque-style and has been declared an Important Cultural Property. It features exhibits on people's lives from ancient times to the present as well as on the relations between Japan and foreign countries. The museum traces the history of the opening of Yokohama Port. Access: 8-min. walk from Kannai or Sakuragicho Sta. or 1-min. walk from Bashamichi

Sta., Open: 9:30-17:00 (enter by 16:30), Closed: Mon. (except national holidays), the last Tue. of each 2-3 months and the New Year's holiday. Admission: ¥300

③ **Silk Center** (シルクセンター) Tel. (045)641-0841, The Silk Museum on the 2nd and 3rd floors. The museum displays the silk manufacturing process and various kinds of silk products. Access: 15-min. walk from Kannai Sta. or 3-min. walk from Nihon-Odori Sta., Open: 9:00-16:30 (enter by 16:00), Closed: Mon. (the following day if Mon. is a national holiday), and the New Year's holiday. Admission: ¥500

④ **Yokohama Doll Museum** (横浜人形の家) Tel. (045)671-9361, facing Yamashita Park, houses about 13,000 dolls from around the world. Access: 13-min. walk from Ishikawacho Sta. or 2-min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. Open: 10:00-18:30 (enter by 18:00), Closed: 3rd. Mon. (except Jul. Aug. Dec. when 3rd. Mon. falls on a national holiday, it's open and closed on the following day) and during the New Year's holiday. Admission: ¥500

⑤ **Mitsubishi Minatomirai Industrial Museum** (三菱みなとみらい技術館) Tel. (045)224-9031, in Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (Mitsubishi Juko) Yokohama Bldg. Access: 8-min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. or 3-min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta. Open: 10:00-17:30 (enter by 16:30), Closed: Mon. (when Mon. falls on a national holiday, the following day is closed.), 5 continuous days in last Feb. and mid-Sep., the New Year's holiday. Admission: ¥300

⑥ **Yokohama Park** (横浜公園) was constructed in 1876. Yokohama Stadium, the home ground of Yokohama Bay Stars Baseball Team, is in the park. Access: 1-min. walk from Kannai Sta.

⑦ **Yamashita Park** (山下公園) one of the oldest seaside park in Japan, stretches for about 1,000 meters along Yokohama Harbor.

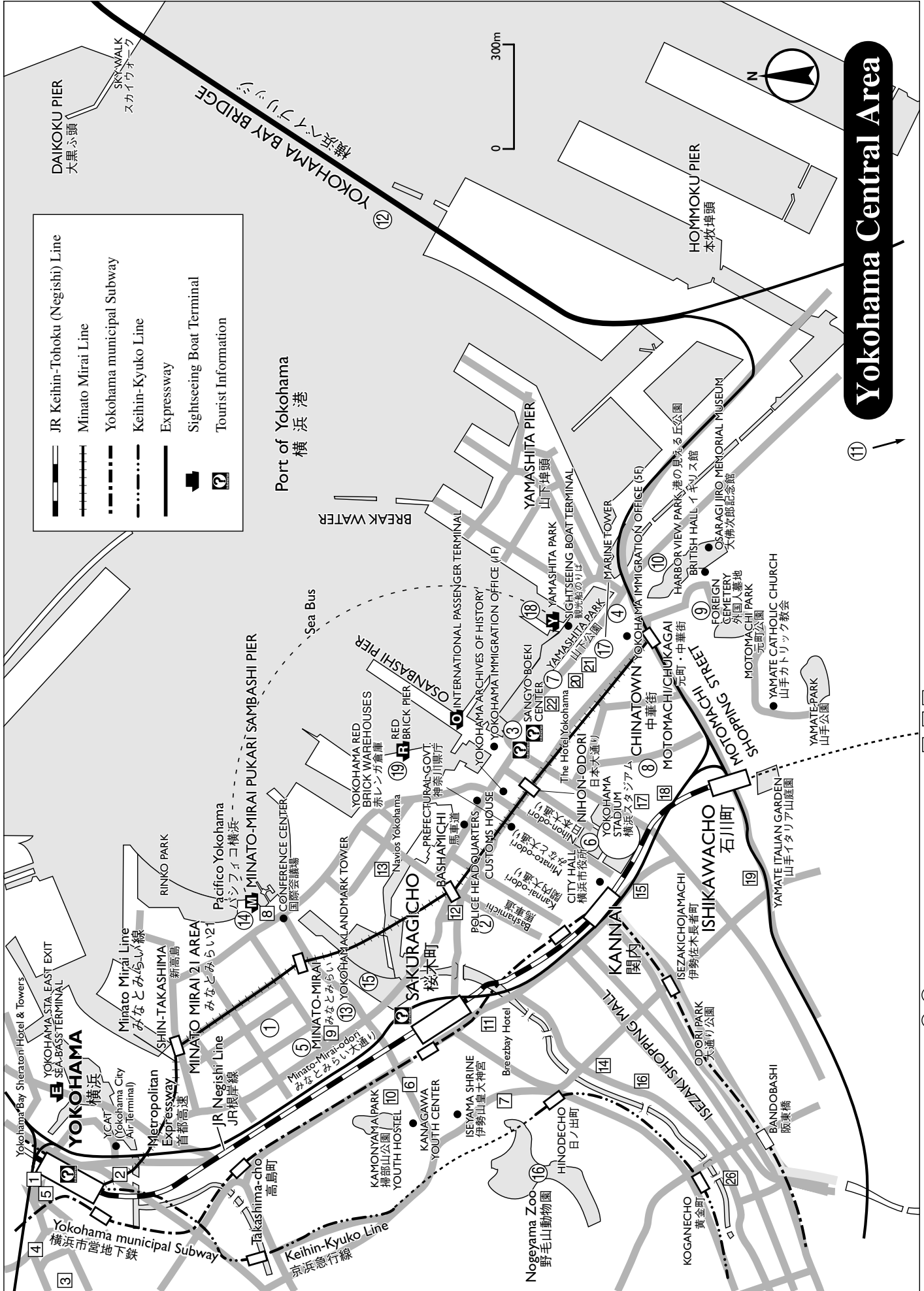
⑧ **Chinatown** (中華街), bordered by four different-colored Chinese gates (called Pairo) facing each compass direction, is built around the Chinese shrine called Kanteibyō, which enshrines the god of commerce. The blue east gate signifies prosperity, the white west one peace, the red south one happiness and the black north one posterity. About 600 restaurants and shops line its bustling streets. Access: 1-min. walk from Motomachi / Chukagai Sta. Refer to the map of Chinatown on page 4/7.

⑨ **Yokohama Foreign General Cemetery** (外国人墓地) Tel. (045)622-1311, lies on the bluff commanding a grand view of the city. The cemetery contains some 4,000 graves of foreigners who contributed to Japan's opening to the world. Open: Graves 12:00-16:00 on Sun. (end-Mar.-mid-Apr.) and Fri., Sat. & Sun. (Apr.-Nov.). Museum 10:00-17:00 (except Mon.) Admission is free, but donation for maintaining graves is required. Access: 8-min. walk from Motomachi/Chukagai Sta. or 20 min. by bus from Sakuragicho Sta.

⑩ **Harbor View Park** (港の見える丘公園) is a hilltop park which offers a good view of the harbor area. Access: 7-min. walk from Motomachi/Chukagai Sta. or 10 min. by bus from Sakuragicho Sta.

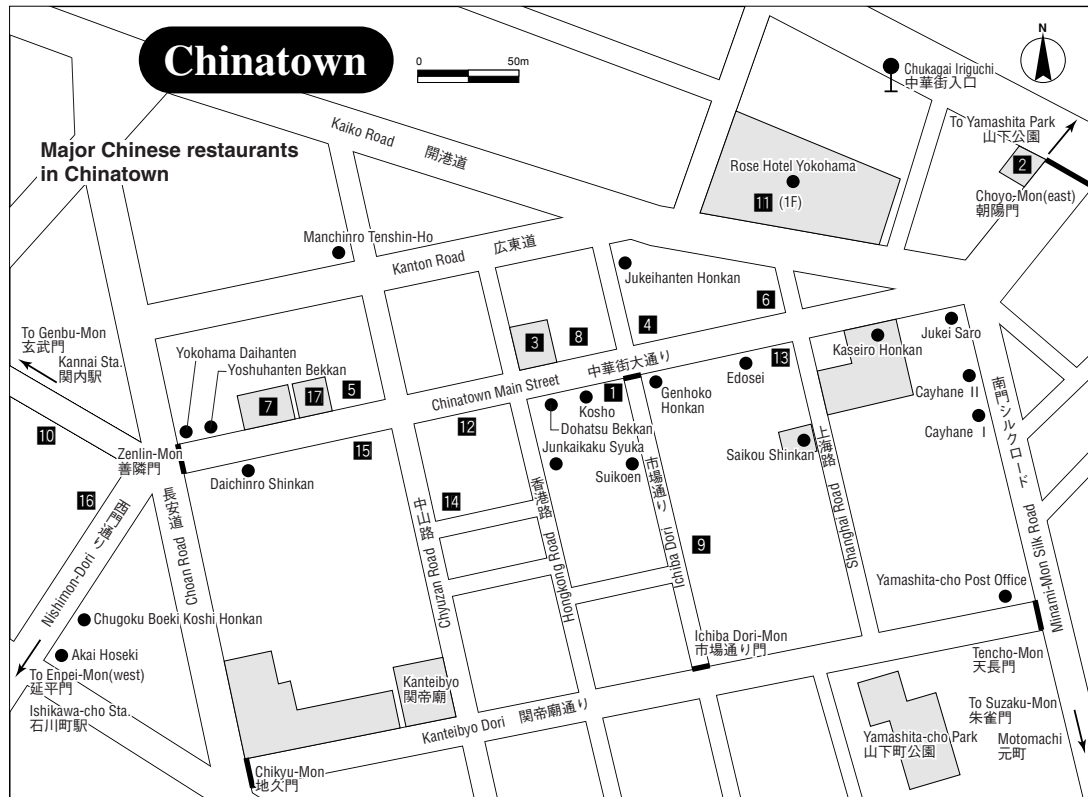
⑪ **Sankeien Garden** (三溪園) Tel. (045)621-0634, a purely Japanese-style landscape garden, was originally laid out by Tomitaro Hara (1868-1939) one of the big raw silk exporters in Yokohama. Accenting the main garden is an impressive three-story pagoda and graceful garden bridges. An inner garden contains several old houses and farm buildings as well as Important Cultural Properties such as Rinshunkaku Villa and Choshukaku House. Access: 25 min. by bus No. 8 or No. 148 from Sakuragicho Sta. to Hommoku-Sankeien-mae bus stop then 3 min. walk. Open: 9:00-17:00 (enter by 16:30) Closed: Dec. 29-31. Admission: ¥500

⑫ **Yokohama Bay Bridge** (横浜ベイブリッジ) is the gateway to the Yokohama Port. This suspension bridge, 860 meters long and 3 lanes wide on each side, with 176 cables stretching diagonally from the pillars supporting the bridge, is a part of the Metropolitan Expressway. A scenic view of the port can be seen from the observatory under the bridge. Access: 18 min. from

⑬ **Yokohama Landmark Tower** (横浜ランドマークタワー) Tel. (045)222-5030, 296 meters high with 70 stories above ground and three levels underground, is Japan's tallest skyscraper. There are many shops, restaurants and a hotel. Visitors can also enjoy the panoramic view. A 40-second ride on the world's fastest elevator skyrockets you to the 69th floor's Sky Garden, the highest observatory in Japan. Open: 10:00-21:00 (enter by 20:30), 10:00-22:00 (Sat., Jul. 21-Aug. 31 enter by 21:30), Open year round. Access: 3-min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta. or 5 min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. Admission: ¥1,000

⑭ **Pacifico Yokohama** (パシフィコ横浜) Tel. (045)221-2155, is a major international convention center consisting of a convention hall, conference center, and an exhibition hall. On the premises is Inter Continental The Grand Yokohama Hotel, 31-story high and built in the form of a sail. Access: 3-min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta.

⑮ **Sail Training Ship Nippon-Marū & Yokohama Maritime Museum** (帆船日本丸・横浜マリタイムミュージアム) Tel: (045) 221-0280. Nippon-Marū was built in 1930 for students of the mercantile schools. Trained volunteer open all sails and display the full sailed Nippon-Marū about 10 times a year. The Yokohama Maritime Museum, which specializes in ports and ships, is located next to the Nippon Maru. Access: 5-min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. Open: 10:00-17:00, 10:00-18:30 (Sat., Sun., national holidays in Jul.-Sep.), enter by 30 min. before each closing time. Closed for Ship and Museum: Mon. (The following day when Mon. is a national holiday), Dec.29-31. Admission: ¥600

⑯ **Nogeyama Zoo** (野毛山動物園) Tel. (045)231-1696, has about 1100 animals. Access: 15-min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta., Open: 9:30-16:30 (enter by 16:00), Closed: Mon. (when Mon. falls on a national holiday, the following day is closed.), Dec.29-Jan.3. Admission: free

⑰ **Marine Tower** (マリンタワー), at 106 meters high, is the tallest inland lighthouse in the world, with an observatory located 100 meters above ground. Access: 1-min. walk from Motomachi/Chukagai Sta., Note: Although now this facility is closed because of renovation, it is expected to complete by spring 2009. Please inquire for more information at Tourist Information center.

⑱ **Hikawa Maru** (氷川丸), is a 12,000-ton passenger ship used from 1930 to 1960. Access: 3-min. walk from Motomachi/Chukagai Sta., It is currently (as of August 2007) closed because of renovation. It will reopen in Spring 2008.

⑲ **Yokohama Red Brick Warehouses** (横浜赤レンガ倉庫), were built as national warehouses between 1911-1913 and operated as a logistics exchange point of the port of Yokohama. Now they are used as cultural and commercial facilities. The shopping mall in the second warehouse is open 11:00-20:00 (restaurants: depend on each shops). Tel: (045) 227-2002. 6-min. walk from Bashamichi Sta. or Nihon-odori Sta.

**Yokohama Zoological Gardens Zoorasia** (よこはま動物園ズーラシア) Tel. (045)959-1000, is a zoological garden with 7 different themes. As Asian Tropical Forest, Subarctic Forest, Oceanian Glassland, Central Asian Highland, Japanese Countryside, African Tropical

**Yokohama International Swimming Pool** (横浜国際プール) Tel. (045)592-0453, is a comprehensive sports center which has facilities such as a pool, a training room and tennis courts. **Yokohama History Museum** (横浜市歴史博物館) Tel. (045)912-7777. Displays around the theme of the "People who lived in Yokohama" deal with the history of the city environs over a 20,000 year period. Access: 5-min. walk from Center-kita Sta. Open: 9:00-17:00 (enter by 16:30), Closed: Mon. (if Mon. is a national holiday, the following day is closed.), the New Year holiday. Admission: ¥400 (permanent exhibition)

### Major Events in Yokohama:

Feb.: Shunsetsu, or Chinese New Year's Day occurs according to the lunar calendar in Chinatown. Chinese entertainment galore including the ever-popular dragon dance.

May: The Yokohama fancy dress parade with baton twirlers and folk dancers starts in front of Yamashita Park, passing along main streets of the city.

Late May: Kaiko Kinen Bazaar, a huge annual bazaar is held for one week at Yokohama Koen (park) adjacent to Yokohama Stadium.

Jun.: Yokohama Kaiko-sai, Festival at Rinko Park, many marine events are held during the day. (live concerts, fire works, etc.)

Late Jul.: Hanabi Taikai (fireworks display) at Yamashita Park.

Late Aug.: Yokohama Carnival is a lively sprawling event staged in Yokohama.

Oct. 1: National Festival (anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China at Chinatown).

Oct. 10: Sojuzetsu (anniversary of the founding of the Republic of China) is celebrated in Chinatown.

Early-Oct.: Yokohama Jazz Promenade. You can enjoy hundreds of jazz sessions at more than 90 places (Hikawa Maru concert halls, live houses in Yokohama, etc.).

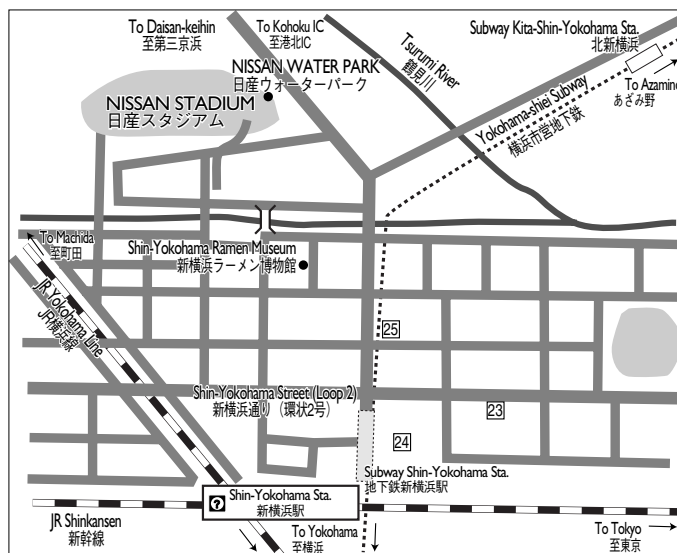
